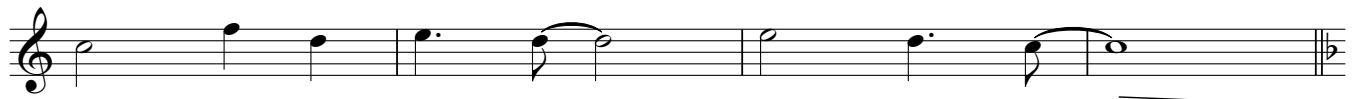
Violin 2

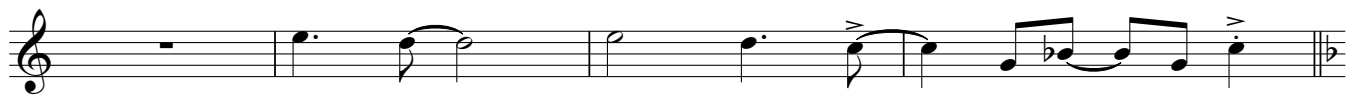
Flute 1
